Adult learners and their tutors will be honored for a "job well done" having completed a successful nine-month program to improve reading, writing and math skills. Tutoring is held weekly at D'Estee and Jackson Park Supportive Living locations. Also, the Delta Literacy Book Club, "Yes, We Can!" turns 10! Having read such classics as "A Gathering of Old Men," and "Of Mice and Men," this club of adult learners just finished reading and attending the movie "A Chance in the World."

The Delta Literacy Project is an Adult Basic Education Program and participating students must be reading 8.6 or below. One-on-one tutoring is offered and supported by volunteer tutors both from the community and the sorority. Delta Literacy has functioned successfully nearly 30 years, since 1988.
